The ADEQ continues to recognize WEFTEC for continuing education credit towards Arkansas Wastewater Operators license renewal hours.

The following is a breakdown of the hours operators can expect to receive for their participation in WEFTEC 2017. These will apply towards continuing education/license renewal training hour requirements:

Exhibition - Up to **24 Contact Hours** for Arkansas wastewater operators attending the 3-day exhibition portion of your conference (Monday – Wednesday)

Workshops - Up to **12 CEU Hours** (6 hours per day) for Workshops (Saturday-Sunday)

Technical Sessions - Up to **16.5 Professional Development Hours** for Technical Sessions attended Monday through Wednesday

Operations Challenge - Up to **12 CEU Hours** for Monday and Tuesday's team participants

Facility Tours - Maximum hours allocated for each tour (Mon. = **2GCH** / Tues. = **6GCH** / Wed. = **3GCH**)

Attendees may attach with this form any certificates of completion (or other verification) issued for their attendance, however it is not required.
